From the Pastor:

As we end the month of August and enter the month of September, we prepare for summer vacation to end and for school to begin. We are also drawing very close to October 31st, which will mark the 500th Anniversary of the beginning of the Reformation. Through a series of parish visitations, Martin Luther realized that there was an appalling ignorance of the Bible and basic Christian teachings on the part of both the pastors and the lay people of Saxony. In order to address the problem, Luther wrote two catechisms in 1529. The Large Catechism was written to educate pastors so that they could preach and teach correctly. The Small Catechism was written to teach lay people the basics of the Christian faith. With the publication of his two Catechisms, Martin Luther established Christian Education as a vital and essential part of the Lutheran Church.

On Sunday, August 27th, we will observe "Christian Education Sunday." Our Sunday School teachers will be installed and we will present Bibles to our 5th Graders during the worship service. We will also be singing Sunday School songs that have been used here for decades, so they will be familiar to both children and adults. During the Sunday School period, we will have a special blessing of the children and their school backpacks and supplies, and our students will be promoted to their new classes. Steve Hikes will begin an Adult Sunday School class series on Luther's Small Catechism. We are anticipating an enthusiastic turn-out on August 27th so that we can get our new Sunday School year off to a grand beginning!

In September, we will prepare our Third Graders for their First Communion, and we will resume our Confirmation Classes for our 7th, 8th, and 9th Graders. Pastor will also resume teaching our "Wednesday Night Live" classes on the history of the Christian Church.

St. Peter's has many opportunities for Christian Education, for all ages – so come and join us in the fun of learning about the love of God and our Lutheran heritage!

Highlights from the July 6th Council Meeting

The Property Committee reported that several repairs were done in the Church. Another vendor is being contacted to bid on the video hook-up project. The Church furnace needs a new expansion tank. The Church kitchen dishwasher needs to be replaced, and a Council member offered to pay for a new dishwasher. The parsonage furnace is leaking carbon monoxide, and the Council voted to replace it at a cost of \$6,000.

The Christian Education Committee will meet at 6:00 PM and the Evangelism Committee will meet at 7:30 PM on April 24th. The Worship Committee will meet on April 20th.

The Worship Committee will arrange for dry cleaning the choir robes. Some changes are being introduced in the Sunday services, and the Committee is looking for feedback from the Congregation.

The Evangelism Committee noted that churches are using social media to reach out and suggested that St. Peter's needs to utilize social media. The Council approved the establishment of a Technology Committee to develop a social media policy.

The Stewardship Committee reported that Stewardship Sunday will be held on November 19th, with a Temple Talk and the distribution of Time and Talent Sheets.

Under New Business:

Sister Janet Stump will be invited to preach on July 23rd as a "make-up" Anniversary service.

Confirmation Class News

Our Confirmation Classes are ready to begin the 2017-2018 class year.

CHRISTIAN EDUCATION SUNDAY

"Christian Education Sunday" will be held on August 27th this year. Our Sunday School teachers will be installed and we will present Bibles to our 5th Graders during the 9:00 AM worship service. Two of our 5th Graders will serve as lectors and read Scripture lessons from their new Bibles. We will have a special Children's message, and we will also be singing Sunday School songs that have been used here for decades, so they will be familiar to both children and adults. The Senior Choir will be doing a special anthem. We encourage parents to bring their children to the Church worship service as well as to the Sunday School hour for this special day.

During the Sunday School period, we will have a special blessing of the children and their school backpacks and supplies, and our students will be promoted to their new classes.

Beginning August 27th, the Adult Class, led by Steve Hikes, will study Luther's *Small Catechism* using the resource book *Free to Be* by Gerhard Forde and James Nestigen, retired Professors at Luther Seminary in St. Paul, Minnesota. The Adult Class meets in the Sanctuary, near the piano, and new members are always welcome!

We have Sunday School classes for all ages from Nursery through Adult. Our teachers prepare Bible-based lessons, and there are crafts for the younger classes. Barb Hikes leads music for all of the classes, with a mixture of old classics and new tunes that the students really enjoy. Everyone is welcome for Sunday School, which runs from 10:30 to 11:30 AM every Sunday. See you there!

First Communion Class

A special Class will be held on Sunday, September 10th, from 2:00 to 3:30 P.M., to prepare our Third Graders to receive their First Holy Communion. All Third Graders and their parents are invited to attend this session. First Communion will be received on World Communion Sunday (October 1, 2017) at the 9:00 A.M. Worship Service.
